# 2002 Recognition Award Winners Announced

Five winners of the 2002 US Recognition Awards were announced at the Groupwide Meeting held in San Francisco on Monday, October 21st. They represent a crosssection of BGI's businesses and include two Associates, two Principals, and a Managing Director.

Judging the winners was a difficult process, according to this year's coordinator, Jas Rangi. "The judges spent several hours as a group in reaching their decision," she said. "With so many strong nominations, it was challenging to have to choose a handful of winners."

### Carlton Burgess Administrative Assistant, Advanced Strategies & Research Group
